### **Team Managers Information**

**Registration & Briefing:** 15 mins before individual tee-times

**Tournament Timings:** Individual tee-off times from 11:45am

**Format:** An 18-hole Individual & team stableford, for under 18's.

**Schedule of Play:** sent 2 weeks before event

#### **Rules**

Entrants must hold an active EGU of less than 20 and be able to provide a CDH number.

#### **RESOLUTION OF TIES:**

In the event of a tie, winners will be decided on the basis of their nett score- either individually or an accumulation of the 3 team scores- over the last nine, six, three or final holes.

#### **RESTRICTIONS:**

Entrants are not permitted caddies. No parent or school representative should be within 50 metres. Unless they are providing medical assistance, failure to comply may result in disqualification.

#### **Cancellation Policy**

Please understand that spaces for our events are limited. Many teams and individuals drop out of events at short notice, this significantly impacts on the experience of other participants. If you must cancel your space, we respectfully request at least 14 days' notice. This will allow us to offer your spot to another school. No shows, or places cancelled within 14 days of the event, will incur a fee of £150. (Only in exceptional circumstances might ISA consider waiving this penalty charge.)

#### **General Information**

##### **Awards**

A trophy will be awarded to the individual player with the best nett score.

A Silver and Bronze medal will be awarded to the 2nd and 3rd Place best nett scores

A Team Trophy will be awarded to the school with the lowest aggregate score (team of three to count) with a gold medal for each of the three players.

There will be a presentation after the event. Winners or their representatives are expected to stay for the presentation.

##### **Equipment**

Competitors must come fully equipped.

### **Parking**

We ask that all vehicles to be parked in Worksop College's overflow car park. Which will be sign posted on the day of the event. (if we do tee off in an afternoon the golf club may lock the gates as early as 4:30pm, therefore after the presentation they may be locked in.)

### **Spectators**

Parents and spectators are welcome to attend the tournament. Provided they keep a minimum of 50m away from players and do not offer advice during play.

### **Safeguarding**

Whilst event staff will be on hand, we can not follow every group for 18 holes. Therefore, we ask that the school brings sufficient staff to ensure the safety of their pupils throughout the day.

### **Catering/Refreshments**

Players are advised to bring their own food and drink for the tournament. Post round replenishment will be available at Worksop College, immediately prior to the presentation. \*Please note, no U18 is allowed in the Golf Club bar area.
