Pupils are invited to decorate eggs to celebrate Easter. The design must be 3D and can be created in any way you like. We will be looking for the most fun and creative eggs!

Eligibility

This competition is open to ISA Members' schools only. Schools can submit a maximum of ten entries in total to the competition. Entries can be made by individuals or groups.

We encourage schools to run a competition in house first and submit their best entries. You can also set a theme within your class and set up one or few scenes to take group photos of the eggs decorated.

At ISA, we are committed to making our opportunities accessible, we welcome applications from all pupils, including those with learning difficulties or disabilities. Alternative formats of these guidelines are available on request. Please notify us at the earliest opportunity so we can provide the document accordingly, if required.

How to enter

Entries must be submitted via the online entry form on the ISA website [here](#) by **Monday 24 March 2025**

- You must submit a JPEG photograph of your entries
- All files must be named in the following format: school name followed by the pupil or group name e.g. SchoolName_JohnSmith

Rules

- Participants can use polystyrene or other eggs from different material if they are the same dimensions as a real egg.
- Participants can decorate more than one egg per artwork.
- A drawing of an egg will not be accepted in the competition, entries must be 3D. You can use anything you want to decorate your egg.
- Artwork must have been produced within 12 months of the competition deadline. All entries must be submitted based on the pupil's age and key stage at the time of creation.
